⁵The LORD saw that the wickedness of man was great in the earth, and that every intention of the thoughts of his heart was only evil continually.

⁶And the LORD was sorry that he had made man on the earth, and it grieved him to his heart. ⁷So the LORD said, "I will blot out man whom I have created from the face of the land, man and animals and creeping things and birds of the heavens, for I am sorry that I have made them."

⁸But Noah found favour in the eyes of the LORD.

The horror of Judgment...

1. Divine judgment is necessary

Intellectually, because of the
"naturalness" of violence

Emotionally, because of the
poison of violence

Culturally, because of the
endlessness of violence

2. Divine judgment is deserved (v5-7)

Our hearts are wicked

God's heart is pained

Therefore God judges

3. Divine judgment is not God's ultimate purpose - salvation is (v8)
