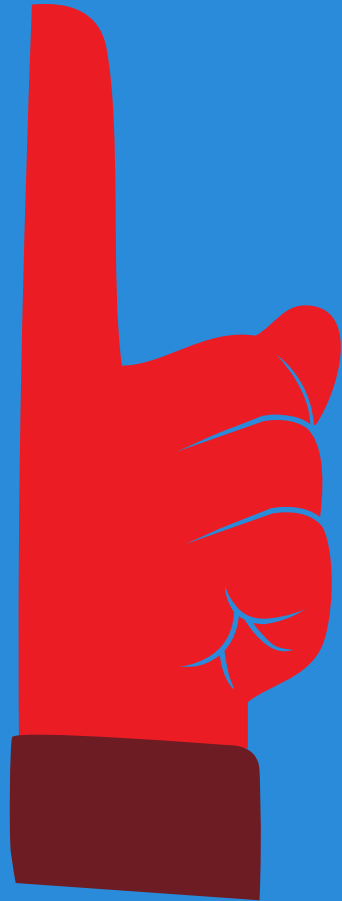


# ONE THING IN COMMON
